LICENSE RENEWAL – REVOCATION OF PELLCO CEU COURSES

Before renewing your Utah license which expires November 30, 2012, you must complete your continuing education (CE) hours.

***Plumbers: 12 hours.** Eight Core and the other four may be either Core or Professional.

***Electricians: 16 hours.** Twelve Core and the other four may be either Core or Professional.

***Apprentices:** If you are currently enrolled in an approved Utah apprenticeship program, your school will report your CE hours to DOPL.

Courses must be selected from the DOPL CE Registry at www.utah.gov/ce-public. These classes cover a wide spectrum of topics, are offered by professional training providers and generally require a participation fee. Following completion of an approved course, the CE provider will submit your CE information to DOPL electronically. We do not accept certificates.

PLEASE PLAN AHEAD! Allow time for the CE courses to be posted before attempting to renew. If you wait until the last week before expiration to resolve this issue, renewal of your license may be delayed until after your license expires. **You cannot renew your license without CE hours.**

You may verify the CE hours DOPL has received for your license at www.utah.gov/ce-public. Type your license number in the box under “Courses Taken” on the right of the screen. A list of those courses submitted by your CE provider to DOPL will appear on the left.

Revocation of Pellco CEU Courses

In today’s Construction Services Commission meeting, the Commission revoked the approval of all Pellco continuing education courses for plumbers and electricians as of October 31st, 2012. In order to accommodate licensees who may have completed a Pellco course and mailed it prior to October 31st, 2012, Pellco has until November 10th, 2012 to upload any verification of completion that may be submitted to Pellco prior to that date.
