**ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:
MINUTES:**

Mr. Nielson made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 15, 2007 meeting as written. Ms. Bearnson seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

APPOINTMENT:

Lloyd Ray Knowles
Denial of Reinstatement

Mr. Knowles appeared for an interview with the Board regarding his reinstatement application. Mr. Jones gave a brief explanation of why the hearing was changed to an interview. Each Board member was given a copy of Mr. Knowles application and his court documents. Mr. Knowles was issued a citation for unlicensed practice. His license expired more than two years ago which requires a person to complete a new application and meet the current requirements. Mr. Nielson worked with Mr. Knowles close to the

time of his conviction. He indicated it will not effect his decision. Mr. Jones gave copies of the statute regarding good moral character and criminal conduct. The ARE taken at the time he was originally license is comparable to the current ARE. Mr. Jones feels the issue is whether his experience is comparable to IDP. Mr. Nielson feels that IDP is very important and there should be a more severe consequence than a fine for letting your license lapse for more than two years. Mr. Knowles indicates he has a current NCARB Council Record, but the Board explained that without a current license the NCARB Council Record would not be current. Mr. Naylor feels that requiring IDP for a person who has practiced for 30 years will not make them more qualified for license. His 30 years of practice should be enough experience. Action against his license for a conviction twelve years ago would not be effective. Ms. Jackson asked if he had been stamping drawing during this time and he indicated that he stamped 7 or 8 projects.

Mr. Naylor made a motion to grant reinstatement of Mr. Knowles' architect license. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Four votes were cast in favor of the motion. Mr. Nielson voted against the motion. Motion passed with four votes in favor and one vote against.

Mr. Naylor does not feel that there is a HSW threat by reinstating Mr. Knowles license. Mr. Miller asked if this is a recommendation to DOPL and Mr. Jones indicated that the decision is ultimately Mr. Stanley's.
