**DECISIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

**ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:**  
**Mr. David Stanley**

Mr. Stanley discussed with the Board the issue of Ms. Baker leaving the Division in a few months. He introduced Ms. Noel Taxin as the new Bureau Manager for the Osteopathic Physicians Licensing Board. The Board welcomed Ms. Taxin and thanked Diana for a job well done.

**MINUTES:**

The minutes from the 11/15/2007 meeting were reviewed. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes as written.

**BOARD BUSINESS:**

Ms. Baker asked Dr. Peterson if he is interested in going to the Federation Meeting. Dr. Warren declined and Ms. Baker stated she will discuss this matter with Dr. Loomis.

**DISCUSSION ITEM:**

Mr. Ron Kunzler asked to have this meeting today to

Dr. Larry Andrew

discuss a letter from Dr. Larry Andrew's Attorney, and the probationary status while he is incarcerated. Mr. Kunzler discussed the procedure of an emergency hearing and the purpose of protecting the public. After the hearing his license was suspended. Another hearing was held and his license was reinstated. About a year later a Criminal Hearing was held and at this time Dr. Andrew was sentenced to jail for a period of one year. DOPL has issued a Stipulation and Order placing Dr. Andrew's licenses on probation for a period of 5 years. Mr. Kunzler asked the Board if they wanted to have Dr. Andrew come before the Board for his quarterly interviews. The Board discussed the fact that he is not working at this time and, therefore, there would be no reason to have him attend the probation meetings here at DOPL. Mr. Kunzler questioned whether he should submit an employer report monthly stating he is not working and it was decided to not require this since the Board and the Division realizes he is in jail. The Board was concerned as to how Dr. Andrew will practice once he returns to work.

Mr. Kunzler reported that the criminal court ordered that Dr. Andrew may not practice fertility for a period of two years. His incarceration is for one year and after his release he may practice with supervision, as identified in the DOPL Order, but not in fertility. The Board decided to have him return in the fall after his release from jail to discuss his practice plan and supervision, and to go over the terms and conditions of his Order again.
