Transaction Report – Information

The Division was concerned with IFA's (Intermountain Farmers Association's) reporting records. It was explained that IFA sells or has sold "Triodine" at two different percentages, 7% and 2%. After reviewing the product specifications, Mr. Robinson explained that the specification documents are confusing. Mr. Buckner added that the DEA does not restrict this product unless the product contains more than 2.2% of an Iodine derivative. He then added that IFA no longer stocks or sells 7% Triodine.

After a detailed discussion, Ms. Wingert will review the Triodine product specifications, and report to the Division the appropriate content specifications.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Meth Labs Busted in Utah - Deseret Morning News article

A news article from Deseret Morning News, regarding the 2007 "busted" Meth labs, in Utah, was reviewed. Mr. Robinson explained, he felt that the use of the drug has not been eliminated, only the production has been curtailed, Mr. Rapich and Ms. Wingert agreed.

Mr. Jensen questioned if additional substances should be added to 58-37c to curtail the use and/or manufacturing of controlled substances. After a detailed discussion it was determined, no amendments are needed at this time.
