<b>MINUTES</b>	David Wesemann made a motion to approve the November 2009 board minutes as amended. Norman Bennion seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.
<b>INVESTIGATIONS</b>	There was no discussion on investigations. Wayne Jeppson of investigations was unable to attend the meeting.
<b>EDUCATION/ENFORCEMENT FUND</b>	The Education and Enforcement Fund was reviewed.
<b>UTAH SOCIETY OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS/ERIC ANDERSON</b>	Eric Anderson from the Utah Society of Professional Engineers came before the board with a continuing education (CE) fund request of \$3,700.00 for a seminar. The topic of the seminar is advanced engineering principles to real world problems.

The seminar is to be held in May 2010. Bennion made a motion to approve up to \$3,700 of CE funding for this seminar. Gary Knighton seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE RULE/CHANGES**

The board members received copies of the administrative rule that took affect on December 22, 2009.

The board reviewed and once more approved rule language to define highly toxic materials and allowable quantities. The board also reviewed and approved rule changes to the experience and examination requirements that involved the engineering license classifications. The changes were to clarify that qualifying work experience was to be obtained after meeting the education requirements. Jonathan Richards made a motion to approve the proposed rule changes as discussed. Knighton seconded the motion all members voted in favor.

#### **2010 WESTERN ZONE CONFERENCE**

Von Hill indicated arrangements for the NCEES Western and Central Zone Conference is moving forward. Twenty-five states would be represented at the conference involving both zones with approximately 145 attendees. The conference would be held from May 13-15, 2010 in Salt Lake City.
