MINUTES

David Racker made a motion to approve the October 2009 minutes as written. Lars Anderson seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.

BOARD RESIGNATIONS

Harries Lloyd

Mr. Harries Lloyd informed the Board he was resigning his position as the public member of the Board and this would be his last meeting.

David Racker

Mr. David Racker indicated his single term on the Board ended on June 30, 2010. He, due to his health, was not interested in serving another term and needs to be replaced. Both Mr. Lloyd and Mr. Racker were thanked by the Board for their service.

Board Chair Nominations

The Board decided to wait on electing a new chair until new board members were appointed.

Testing

Kent Barnes, testing provider liaison, reviewed the current LARE test scores. Out of twenty-seven testing candidates,

eleven candidates failed. Mr. Barnes discussed the redline review process, but indicated for the next Board meeting he would obtain additional information on the review. This will be an agenda item for the October meeting.

CLARB SPRING MEETING REPORT

Mr. Anderson gave a brief summary of the CLARB Spring Meeting that was held in Dallas, Texas in late February of this year. The CLARB meeting reviewed evaluating CLARB council record for certification, testing, how Boards handle common violations, identifying ways to maintain or increase board efficiency/effectiveness with limited resources, and the role of CLARB to promote the profession.

INVESTIGATIONS

Mr. Wayne Jeppson gave a summary of investigated cases.

WEST JORDAN CITY

The Board discussed that West Jordan City put out a bid for an irrigation central control system for their public parks. The Board was concerned it appeared that West Jordan in their bidding had excluded Landscape Architects.

EDUCATION & ENFORCEMENT FUND

The Education and Enforcement Fund figures were not available.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULE

Mr. Randall Boudrero discussed changing the rule examination requirements to eliminate the Uniform National Examination (UNE). The examination was no longer available and had been replaced by the Landscape Architect Registration Examination (LARE). The Board was *not* in favor of such a change, due to the negative impact it would have on reciprocity and licensees that had taken the UNE.

Mr. Boudrero also suggested changing the eight years experience work requirement. Mr. Dan Jones stated this change would have to be done by statute, not rule. Continuing education was not addressed due to the fact the proposed continuing education bill did not pass the state legislator this year.

Mr. Boudrero suggested the Board come up with ideas on how to define incidental practice as it would apply to Landscape Architecture. This will be an agenda item for the October board meeting.
