MINUTES
The August 2010 board meeting minutes were tabled until the next board meeting in October. The August minutes contained a statement by Wayne Holman of investigations that needed clarification and Holman was not present at this meeting.

COMPLIANCE
Susan Higgs reviewed the probationers with the board. Zachary Chipman was placed on probation last May and had not met with her. Phone contact, however, had been made with him and Chipman was scheduled to meet with her tomorrow, September 2nd. Five probationers provided her with employer reports, but seven had not. Order to show causes were pending against two probationers.

JOEL JACKSON

Joel Jackson, a licensed apprentice plumber, met with the board. Jackson said he wanted to take the journeyman examination. He had finished his apprenticeship education, but had not completed the four year work experience requirement. He was nine months short. The board informed Jackson he would have to complete the experience requirement prior to testing as required by code.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULE
Continuing Education

Robyn Barkdull, the continuing education coordinator, met with the board. According to Barkdull, the continuing education that could be approved for both the individual plumbing license and the contractor license would have to be uploaded separately on the continuing education registry. She was still working out the details with Utah Interactive on how to handle apprentices that were attending school. It would be up to the schools to provide her a list of the attending apprentices.
