DISCUSSION:

Continuing education workshops and proposal for use of Education and Enforcement Fund, Niall Henshaw

The Board reviewed a preliminary application for Geology Education and Enforcement Funds Grant. Mr. Henshaw advised the Board that the CE workshop is scheduled for May 17, 2011 at the Salt Lake Community College. Mr. Henshaw stated they are on course with the schedule. He will be obtaining a list of licensees in the next few weeks. They plan to send notifications by e-mail and US Postal mail on a post card. Mr. Henshaw stated the seminar will be similar to the format of the last one and will be a full day. Mr. Henshaw stated that he is still in the process of establishing instructors. He does not expect there to be a change in the funds needed for this seminar; however, he will keep the Board apprised of any

changes. Mr. Horns motioned to approve the training proposal for \$5,000.00, submitted by Mr. Henshaw, seconded by Mr. Lund. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Lund reviewed the workshops he attended at the ASBOG 2010 Annual Meeting with the Board. The Board discussed the importance of having Utah representation at these meetings.
