He will need to be under general supervision with the supervisor having knowledge about his day to day job assignments. He will need to take a polygraph test every six months for three years, once a year for two years, then at renewal as long as he is on the sex offender list. Mr. Gongaware seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
