Drayton Bailey
Wrong Exam Taken

Mr. Bailey explained why he took the journeyman exams and applied for a journeyman license even though he was only approved for the residential journeyman application. Mr. Shaffer made a motion to reject the journeyman exams and allow him to retake the residential exams without paying the exam fees. He can re-apply for the residential journeyman license after passing the exams without paying the application fee again. Mr. Kingery seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Allred made a motion to accept the journeyman practical exam and not make Mr. Bailey retake the residential journeyman practical exam. Mr. Kingery seconded the motion. Motion passed with four votes in favor. Mr. Shaffer voted against the motion.
