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ROSALYN WOOLSEY, RESPONDENT, submitted an application for licensure as a Radiology Practical Technician on May 12, 2009. RESPONDENT was originally licensed as a Radiology Practical Technician on June 2, 1992, but, allowed the license to expire May 31, 2003. Since that time she has not worked in the profession.

The DIVISION and the RESPONDENT, as evidenced by their signatures to this Memorandum of Understanding, agree that RESPONDENT shall be issued a license to practice as a Radiology Practical Technician, subject to the following conditions, which shall be in effect for six months commencing upon the date this Memorandum of Understanding and Order is approved by the Division Director as evidenced by his signature.

1. RESPONDENT admits the jurisdiction of the Division over it and over the subject matter of this action.
2. RESPONDENT acknowledges that she enters into this Memorandum of Understanding voluntarily, and other than what is contained in this agreement, no promise or threat whatsoever has been made by the Division, or any member, officer, agent or representative of the Division to induce the RESPONDENT to enter into this agreement.
3. RESPONDENT acknowledges that she has been informed of her right to be represented by counsel, and she has chosen not to be represented by counsel.
4. RESPONDENT agrees that within 6 months of the date of the approval of this memorandum of understanding she will complete 15 hours of professional education as defined pursuant to Utah Administrative Code, Subsection R156-54-304(4)(a) thru (d) or have taken and passed the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography Core Examination. Should RESPONDENT fail to complete the hours of professional education or the Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography Core Examination, as set forth here in the RESPONDENT will agree to immediately surrender licensure as a radiology practical technician.

5. This document constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes and cancels any and all prior negotiations, representations, understandings or agreements between the parties. There are no verbal agreements which modify, interpret, construe or affect this Agreement.
