FINDINGS OF FACT

1 The Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing ("the Division") filed a Notice of Agency Action in this matter on January 19, 2012

2 A review of the file was made on February 29, 2012 at the Construction Services Commission ("Commission") meeting in which the Commission moved to table this matter for the next meeting to determine if Respondent had become compliant After review on March 28, 2012, the Commission issued an order revoking Respondent's apprentice electrician license to practice in the state See Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order, dated March 28, 2012

3 Respondent thereafter filed a motion to set aside order ("Respondent's Motion")

4 Respondent has accordingly violated the terms of his probation with the Division but has committed to strictly abiding by the terms of his probation in the future


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5 The Division may refuse to issue a license to an application and may refuse to renew or may revoke, suspend, restrict, place on probation, issue a public reprimand to, or otherwise act upon the license of any licensee that has engaged in unprofessional or unlawful conduct as provided by Utah Code Annotated Subsection 58-1-401(2)

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED Respondent's Motion to set aside the Division's March 28, 2012 order is hereby granted and said license is reinstated subject to the stipulation and order previously entered in DOPL-2009-222
