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**BY THE DIVISION:**

The Division's Stipulation and Order, dated September 2, 2009, in the above-referenced case number is hereby amended as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the probationary condition requiring Respondent to work under the direct supervision of a pharmacist licensed in good standing is amended to require Respondent to work under the **general** supervision of a pharmacist licensed in good standing.

It is further ordered the probationary condition identified in paragraph 8.(2)(w) of the September 2, 2009 Stipulation and Order regarding if Respondent works less than full-time in his licensed profession is amended to allow Respondent to accept part-time work toward the probation time period without adjusting the time on a pro rata basis. Respondent must work at least 16 hours per month to be considered "practicing" in his profession.

It is further ordered the probationary condition restricting Respondent from working in any floating, on-call, PRN, "as needed" pools, or temporary staff agencies is amended to allow Respondent to work on an as needed basis (PRN) only if employed by and working at 4 Care Pharmacy.

All other conditions and restrictions in the September 2, 2009

Stipulation and Order shall remain the same and in effect, unless previously amended.
