
**BY THE DIVISION:**


The Division's Memorandum of Understanding and Order, dated February 18, 2009, in the above-referenced case number, is hereby amended as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the probationary condition requiring Respondent's interaction and treatment of any female patient under age 50 to be observed by a third party at all times is amended to allow Respondent to treat female patients age 35 and older without a chaperone. Respondent must continue to have a chaperone/third party present when treating female patients ages 18 through 34.

All other conditions and restrictions identified in the February 18, 2009 Memorandum of Understanding and Order shall remain the same in effect.
