FINDINGS OF FACT

1 The Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing ("the Division") filed a Notice of Agency Action in this matter on the 1st day of November 2011

2 This action is based upon Division records which show IGD Corporation, (the "Respondent") failed to replace its qualifier within 60 days after the qualifier ceased association with the Respondent as required by Utah Code Annotated 58-55-304(6) Division records indicate the qualifier ceased association with the Respondent on or before June 27th, 2011

3 The Respondent has filed a response to the notice of agency action. However, the response fails to demonstrate that the Respondent has replaced Respondent's qualifier as required by Utah Code Annotated 58-55-304(6). Respondent states they are ceasing operations and will no longer be a business. However, this response fails to meet the requirements for continued license.

Therefore, according to Division records and after a review of Respondent's response in this matter, Respondent has still failed to replace its qualifier as required.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4 Based upon Respondent's failure to replace its qualifier as required by Utah Code Annotated 58-55-304(6), the Respondent has engaged unprofessional conduct as

provided by Utah Code Annotated 58-1-501(2)(a) and Respondent no longer meets the qualification for licensure as provided by Utah Code Annotated 58-55-304(3)-(5)

5 The Division is authorized to revoke the Respondent's contractor license as provided by Utah Code Annotated 58-1-401(1) because the Respondent no longer meets the qualifications for license by having a qualifier as required by Utah Code Annotated 58-55-304(3)-(5)

6 The Division is authorized to revoke the Respondent's contractor license as provided by Utah Code Annotated 58-1-401(2)(a) for engaging in unprofessional conduct as provided by Utah Code Annotated 58-1-501(2)(a) for failure to replace the qualifier as require by Utah Code Annotated 58-55-304(6)

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED Respondent's license to practice as a contractor in this state shall be revoked, effective on the date this order is signed


