The Division's Stipulation and Order, dated November 9, 2012, in the above-referenced case is hereby amended as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the probationary condition requiring Respondent to receive prescriptions from only one prescribing practitioner is amended to allow Respondent to have two prescribing practitioners (Jared Potter and Raul Weston). However, only one of the prescribing practitioners can prescribe controlled substances to Respondent.

All other conditions and restrictions identified in the November 9, 2012 Stipulation and Order shall remain the same and in effect.
