ELECT A CHAIRMAN

MINUTES

The minutes from the January 10, 2005 meeting were approved as written.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE – OPEN AND PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT

Dan Jones explained that due to the Open & Public Meetings Act that passed during the last legislative session, all meetings will now have to be recorded and will be available for purchase by the public. He also reported that agenda items have to be posted 48 hours prior to the meeting. No new business can be voted on. It will need to be placed on the next agenda.

REVIEW STRUCTURAL PORTION OF THE 2006 EDITION OF THE IBC & IRC

The committee discussed the fact that they also need to review the 2006 International Existing Building Code to determine if it can be added to R156-56-701(2). The committee agreed to have the Seismic Committee of SEAU review the IEBC and report back to this committee. Also they will ask them to look at the GSREB, GREB, UCBC and FEMA 356 to see if they are still needed if the IEBC is approved.

Dan reminded the committee that the review of the 2006 code books and the current amendments will need to be completed by the August meeting.

Review of the current amendments was assigned as follows:

Bruce Palmer will review the IRC and the current amendments for the IRC.

Dave Pierson will review amendments 1-30 and 56-64 to the IBC plus the local amendments.

Don Barker will review amendments 31- 36 to the IBC.

Stephen Cohen will review amendments 37-44 to the IBC.

Justin Naser will review amendments 45-55 to the IBC.

Dan Jones asked the committee if they would be willing to review the NFPA 225 Manufacture Housing Installation Standards since the NCSBCS/ANSI 225.1 is no longer being published. They will review it at a later date.
