The oath of office was administered by Dan Jones to the new Commission member, Stephen Handy.

**MINUTES:**

A motion was made by Enzo Calfa to approve the minutes from the September 21, 2007 meeting as written. The motion was seconded

by Michael Martin and it passed unanimously.

#### CONSIDER RECOMMENDATION TO THE DIVISION ON THE RULES HEARING

The Commission discussed the second rule filing and a motion was made by Jim Hier to make a recommendation to the Division to approve the rule filing with the understanding that if the Division receives any written comments, other than the ones heard today, there will be a meeting in December to review them. The motion was seconded by Gilbert Gonzales and the motion passed unanimously.

The Commission discussed the recommendation to the Division for the main rule filing. Following a discussion on the proposed amendment for Section 901.3 and 917.8 of the IPC, a motion was made by Jim Hier to make a recommendation to the Division that the main rule filing be approved with the understanding that if the Division receives any written comments, other than the ones heard today, there will be a meeting in December to review them and that following the outcome of proposed amendment for the IPC Section 901.3 and 917.8 on the national level, it will be reviewed by the Plumbing Advisory Committee again if it does not pass in Palm Springs and Minnesota. The motion was seconded by Richard Lyman and passed unanimously.

#### APPOINTMENT OF LIAISONS TO ADVISORY COMMITTEES

A motion was made by Michael Martin to appoint Gilbert Gonzales as the liaison for the Plumbing Advisory Committee, Enzo Calfa as the liaison to the Unified Code Analysis Council, Stephen Handy as the liaison to the Education Advisory Committee and Travis Ferran as the Liaison for the Electrical Advisory Committee. The motion was seconded by Jim Hier and the motion passed unanimously.

#### DISCUSS PROCEDURES FOR REVIEWING THE 2008 NEC AND THE 2006 AND/OR 2009 IRC

Gilbert Gonzales spoke to the Commission on what the process should be and the possibility of setting up an ad hoc committee to review the two codes. Renee McDonough spoke to the Commission against forming an ad hoc committee and suggested that the review

should be done by the Electrical Advisory Committee with the addition of other interested people. Scott Marsell spoke in favor of forming an ad hoc committee to do the review. A motion was made by Enzo Calfa to appoint Gilbert Gonzales as the chair of the ad hoc committee that would report to the Electrical Advisory Committee. Those members of the advisory committee would be allowed to participate in the ad hoc committee if they chose to do so. The motion was seconded by Jim Hier and it passed unanimously.

**ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Dan Jones reported on the Education Advisory Committee. They are asking the Commission for some additional guidance for the proposed amendment for the composition of this committee. Renee McDonough asked the Commission to consider letting a representative from the electrical community be appointed to this committee. Following further discussion, the Commission asked the Education Committee to make a recommendation in connection with the composition of this committee.

Richard Lyman reported on the Unified Code Analysis Council. They will be reviewing NFPA 45 in connection with laboratories and the allowable quantities of chemicals. There has been a separate committee set up which also involves the Fire Marshal's Code Committee to help with the review.
