Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct in her practice as a vocational rehabilitation counselor when she failed to maintain appropriate documentation as to when eligibility decisions were made and failed to issue some eligibility letters within the 60 day period mandated by federal law by backdating some eligibility letters for clients.

Order:

Respondent was given a public reprimand for engaging in unprofessional conduct in her practice as a vocational rehabilitation counselor. Respondent was also ordered to complete four additional hours of continuing education focusing on ethics.
