

If you are a foreign graduate, and need authorization to test for the NCLEX, you must fulfill these requirements:

If you HAVE NOT been licensed for at least one year in a country outside the U.S., you must submit on of the following:

1. a completed CGFNS Credential Evaluation Service (CES) [Professional Report](#),
2. a [CGFNS VisaScreen](#)
3. a [Visa4Nurses Certificate](#) from [Josef Silny & Associates](#)

If you HAVE been licensed for at least one year in a country outside the U.S., you may use one of the three options listed above, or:

1. Have your educational and license/registration credentials professionally evaluated by a DOPL approved member organization of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES):
