SUBJECT: Changes to 2025 ARRT Documents and Cut Scores

Note changes to the Magnetic Resonance Imaging ARRT examination, which will take place in early 2025.

- The [discipline documents for the Magnetic Resonance Imaging examination](#) administered by the ARRT have been updated and will go into effect on February 1, 2025.

What prompted this change?

ARRT periodically conducts a job analysis to make certain that the certification examination content specifications and the clinical requirements remain comprehensive, accurate, and fair. ARRT, with the help of the professional community, reviews the certification documents every five years. The ARRT Board of Trustees recently approved changes to the discipline documents, which go into effect on February 1, 2025.
