2021 Utah Dental Examination Requirements for Dentist and Dental Hygienist

Dentist Required Licensing Examination

R156-69-302b. Qualifications for Licensure - Examination Requirements - Dentist.

In accordance with Subsections 58-69-302(1)(f) and (g), the examination requirements for licensure as a dentist include the periodontics, endodontics, operative, class 2 restoration, class 3 restoration, and prosthodontics sections and are established as the following:

- (1) the WREB examination with a passing score as established by the WREB;
- (2) the CDCA examination with a passing score as established by the CDCA;
- (3) the SRTA examination with a passing score as established by the SRTA;
- (4) the CRDTS examination with a passing score as established by the CRDTS; o
- (5) the CITA examination with a passing score as established by the CITA.

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic the Utah Dentists and Dental Hygienist Licensing Board and the Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing will accept non-patient examinations which utilize manikins and artificially developed teeth. The manikin examinations offered by WREB and CDCA are approved by the Board and must include clinical demonstration of competence in periodontics, endodontics, operative, class 2 restoration, class 3 restoration and prosthodontics. A patient based exam will also be accepted from SRTA, CRDTS and CITA. The Board prefers patient based exams when available.

Dental Hygienist Required Licensing Examination

- **R156-69-302c.** Qualifications for Licensure Examination Requirements Dental Hygienist. In accordance with Subsections 58-69-302(3)(f) and (g), the examination requirements for licensure as a dental hygienist are established as the following:
 - (1) the WREB examination with a passing score as established by the WREB;
 - (2) the NERB examination with a passing score as established by the NERB;
 - (3) the SRTA examination with a passing score as established by the SRTA; or
 - (4) the CRDTS examination with a passing score as established by the CRDTS

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic the Utah Dentists and Dental Hygienist Licensing Board and the Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing will accept non-patient examinations which utilize manikins and artificially developed teeth. The manikin examinations offered by WREB and CDCA are approved by the Board and must include clinical demonstration of competence in dental hygiene including periodontal and anesthesia. The DHOSCE is also accepted. A patient based exam will also be accepted from SRTA, CRDTS and CITA. The Board prefers patient based exams when available.
